### Alumni Scholars Program Information for the GUIDANCE COUNSELOR

The Northwest Ohio OSU Alumni Club will sponsor scholarships for high school seniors, living in the club area, who plan to attend The Ohio State University. The club's Alumni Scholars Program is based on merit and is a recruitment scholarship. This scholarship program is intended to provide recognition and financial assistance to incoming freshmen or undergraduate students.

#### Who is eligible?

- Be admitted to the university as an incoming freshmen.
- Preferably ranked in the top 10% of their high school classes
- Be recommended by school principals, counselors and/or teachers based on scholastic ability and character.
- Have a record of performance in activities both in school and in the community.
- Impress the Scholarship Committee with a sound interest and positive attitude toward college work.
- Be residents or attend high school in the area in which the participating alumni club's membership is based.

*Please note: There are two OSU Alumni scholarships available in each county (Defiance, Fulton, Henry and Williams). Students should apply to the county in which they attend school. For example, if a student lives in Henry County, but attends school in Fulton County, s/he would apply for the Fulton County scholarship.*

To be considered for a scholarship the student must complete the application which is attached to this email.

Completed applications are to be returned to the club scholarship leader by **January 12, 2018**.

Scholarship Leader Contact Information is printed on the bottom of the second page of the scholarship application.

The club also suggests that the students complete the FAFSA in order to be eligible for any financial need based scholarships. If the student is interested in applying for any university merit based scholarships, the student must do so by applying online by November 1.
