
because it wouldn't be an SEC party without some friendly competition, there is a contest to see what school donates the most toys. Come join your fellow Tigers for some holiday cheer!

Over 150 alumni attended our Homecoming Watch Party at The Whiskey Bar and donated over \$450 and 50

cans of food for the Food Bank of the Rockies. Thank you to all who joined us at the watch party and donated to the cause!

Back in Columbia students, staff, faculty, and alumni joined together for the 102nd year, accomplishing outstanding things and setting new records with numerous events. Here are the highlights of 2013:



- **67,124** fans filled Memorial Stadium to watch MU take on South Carolina.
- 6,237 units of blood collected during the Homecoming Blood Drive. This year, Mizzou collected more blood than ever before, setting a new school record and saving over 19,000 lives in the process.
- **161,585** pounds of food were donated during the Tiger Food Fight food drive, benefiting the Food Bank of Central MO.
