# **REGISTRATION**

- Ten (10) complimentary tickets will be given to each Club prior to the event. It is the Club's sole responsibility to distribute tickets prior to check-in. Tickets and parking will be sent to the Alumni Club liaison at the address listed above.

#### SETUP INFORMATION

#### **ALUMNI CLUB WILL SUPPLY**

- One 10x10 pop-up tent, table linens, coolers, decorations, etc.
- Food and beverages are encouraged. Items may not be served until 5:30PM.
  - Food: Crockpots and warming trays may be used. Open flames are strictly prohibited.
  - o Beverages: Hard alcohol is prohibited. Non-Pepsi products are prohibited, Aquafina water only.
  - o FCSports reserves the right to discard any competing products inside the stadium complex.

# FLORIDA CITRUS SPORTS WILL PROVIDE

- (1) 8 ft. table, (4) chairs
- (1) standard power outlet
  - Clubs are required to contact FCSports concerning displays that do not fit on the 8' table or within your 10' x 10' tent space. These items must be approved by FCSports.

#### ALUMNI PARKING & CHECK-IN (Tinker Field & Gate F)

- Two (2) parking passes for **Tinker Field** will be provided to each Club prior to the event.
- 2:30PM 5:00PM: Tinker Field Parking Lot opens at 2:30PM. Guests will unload then proceed to check-in at Gate F. You will be directed to the field and your tent location by FCSports ambassadors.
- FCSports Ambassadors will be available to assist with setup and breakdown on a first-come, first-serve basis. Golf carts are available to transport equipment.
- Tickets, ID's, wristbands & cups will be handled at Gate F.
- All check in and set up should be complete by 5:00PM to ensure you're show-ready prior to 5:30PM.

#### **AWARDS AND JUDGING**

Florida Citrus Sports provides a platform for friendly competition among Alumni Clubs. This competition is for **FUN**, and we would like for everyone to enjoy in the festivities.

Two awards will be given out: the Alumni Spirit Award and the Alumni Tailgating Olympic Champion. The schedule for the awards will be as followed:

6:30 PM	Judging begins for Alumni Spirit Award
6:45 PM	Alumni Tailgating Olympics begin
8:00 PM	Ballots will be collected, winners announced shortly after

# **ALUMNI AWARDS CRITERIA**

#### **Spirit Award**

The Alumni Spirit Award will be judged in four categories: Alumni Vote, Interaction, Creativity, and Overall Presentation. If your Alumni Club chooses not to participate in the Alumni Spirit vote, you will be eliminated from receiving the Spirit Award. The club with the highest score will receive the Alumni Spirit Award!

# Alumni Vote: 5 points

- o Each Alumni Club will receive one vote.
- o All 5 points will be awarded to the Club with the most Alumni Club votes.
- You may NOT vote for your own Club.

#### Interaction: 10 points

The amount of interaction extended to all guests.

#### Creativity: 15 points

o Presentation of items exclusive to the College, displayed creatively and uniquely.

# **Overall Presentation: 20 points**

- o The amount of excitement generated by the booth.
- The amount of glitter and pizzazz, and the ability to stand out in the crowd.
- Each Club will perform their fight song/famous cheer in front of the judges.
- o The Clubs will be notified when the judges are a few booths away and at their booth.



# **ALUMNI TAILGATING OLYMPICS**

Alumni Clubs are invited to compete in the 3<sup>rd</sup> Annual Alumni Tailgating Olympics consisting of three events: Corn Hole, Water Pong, and Football Toss. **Each group must nominate separate competitors to compete in each event.** Competition will take place in the North East corner of the field. Clubs will be broken into three time slots with 20 minutes dedicated to each. The first session will begin promptly at 6:45PM, the second at 7:05PM, and the final session at 7:25PM. Each group will be given their designated time slot at check-in and it will be their responsibility to attend their appropriate session.

# **OFFICIAL OLYMPICS CRITERIA**

#### **Event #1: Corn Hole**

- o Each Alumni Club must nominate one competitor to toss 5 bags at a Corn Hole board.
- Competitors will receive 2 points for each bag that goes completely through the hole, and 1
  point for each bag that lands on the surface of the board.
- Point determinations will be made after the fifth toss. [In other words, if the first tossed bag lands on the rim of the surface, but is then knocked through the hole by the second tossed bag, the competitor will receive 2 points for the first toss.]
- o A playoff round will be held only if there is a tie for first place.

#### Event # 2: Water Pong

- Each Alumni Club must nominate one competitor to toss 5 ping pong balls at 10 plastic cups arranged in a triangular formation on an 8 foot table.
- Competitors will receive 1 point for each ping pong ball that lands in a cup, in which the competitors will then remove that cup. No re-racks.
- A playoff round will be held only if there is a tie for first place.

# **Event #3: Football Toss**

- Each Alumni Club must nominate one competitor to compete for the longest football toss.
- o Competitors will receive two throws, with only the longest throw counting in the competition.

#### **Determination of Overall Tailgating Olympics Champion**

- The first, second, and third place finishers in each Tailgating Olympics event will receive the following Olympic Championship Points:
  - 1st Place: 3 points2nd Place: 2 points3rd Place: 1 point
- The Alumni Club with the most Olympic Championship Points will be crowned Alumni Tailgating Olympics Champion.
- A championship playoff will be held only if there is a tie for first place. The playoff will be held in the Olympic Event in which the tied Alumni groups both/all scored the fewest points, or, if there is no such event, Corn Hole.
