

Development of mission statement

Key Survey Results: Club Goals

All respondents (100%) view club as way to casually stay in touch with UNC alumni

only minority for community service, fund raising

High support for database access, offline club events (incl. annual meeting)

moderate support for online services/networking; minimal support for fund raising Words from free comments: "connect", "platform", "network", "raise awareness for UNC"

Key Survey Results: Club Events

Vast majority (89%) for current set-up of annual national meeting

only minority for community service, fund raising; some openness for excursions/visits (~40%)

Majority willing to pay for events (11-50€); volunteer help with organization

Help offered: finding venues (66%), money (55%), finding speakers (50%)

Maximum of 1-3 events per year (>80%); preference for close proximity

moderate support for online services/networking; minimal support for fund raising

Words from free comments: "social events", "personal meetings"

Key Survey Results: Club Structure

Almost everyone (94%)
prefers e-mail
communication

support for website; little interest in LinkedIn/Xing/Twitter

Most support to establish club leader (83%), communications coordinator (66%), co-leader (50%); majority for positions for 2 or more years (61%)

little support for treasurer

No respondent willing to be club leader/co-leader

1/3 can't envision any leadership position; help offered: volunteers for events (50%)

Words from free comments: "continuity", "permanent leader", "no centralization"
